



## ENOWNED for the surrounding hills and the River Dee, Llangollen has something for every visitor.

There are a whole range of outdoor activities, but if you just want to relax let the train take the strain and ride on the steam railway or experience peace and tranquility, gliding along the canal on a horsedrawn boat. Llangollen is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site along eleven miles of canal from Gledrid to the Horseshoe Falls via the spectacular Pontcysyllte Aqueduct.

#### Llangollen Steam Railway

Llangollen Railway is the only standard gauge railway in North Wales, situated within an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB)



and runs alongside the River Dee for its entire length, the river is a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI). There is lots to see and do, and you can take a stroll on one of the many local walks before jumping back on the train and ending your day in style.

#### Castell Dinas Brân

Castell Dinas Brân is a medieval castle located within the earthworks of an earlier Iron Age hillfort and was probably built in the 1260s by Gruffudd ap Madog, Lord of Powys Fadog.

Its existence as a castle was shortlived as it was burned down by the Welsh at the time of Edward I's campaign, to prevent it being taken by the English, and abandoned in 1282. The site which rises to 1,000 feet (307m) and, for the energetic, there is a path to the top with the reward of a fantastic view over the valley and to the hills beyond.

## Plas Newydd & The Ladies of Llangollen

Plas Newydd, Llangollen is a stone built house converted into a gothic 'fantasy' by its most famous inhabitants - 'The Ladies of Llangollen'.

The ladies ran away from the life they were expected to live in Ireland in 1778 to set up a new life and home in Wales.

The house has been welcoming

visitors since the arrival of Lady Eleanor Butler and Miss Sarah Ponsonby in 1780 who lived there for the next 50 years. Their notable visitors included The Duke of Wellington, Wordsworth, Shelley and Sir Walter Scott.

#### Walking in Llangollen

Dee Valley Walks is a series of waymarked and graded routes takes in the beautiful scenery, wildlife and history of this stunning area of North East Wales.

The Dee Valley Way and The North Berwyn Way links the two towns of Corwen and Llangollen. The routes are 15 miles/24km in total but if you prefer to pace yourself it can be walked in separate sections. The Llangollen History Trail links the fascinating historical landmarks in the area through a 6 mile/9.5 km waymarked walk.



#### **Berwyn Mountains**

The Berwyn Mountains stretch all the way from Llangollen in the east, along the Dee Valley, to Bala in the west. The highest peak is that of Cadair Berwyn at 830 metres but there are 24 peaks above 600 metres (2000 feet). They are a haven for wildlife and the moorland tops provide habitats for curlews, merlins and red kites. It is a landscape that both opens up to breathtaking vistas and hides intimate corners. Waterfalls. cliffs, moors, burbling streams and wildflower-dotted fields - the Berwyns have these and more. There are two main walks, the North

Berwyn Way and the Dee Valley Way.

#### **Llangollen Food Festival**

For one glorious weekend in October, Llangollen turns into the culinary



centre of Wales as some of Europe's top producers come together at the Llangollen Royal International Pavilion. One of the first and most successful food festivals in Wales, representatives from as far afield as Spain, Poland, Italy and France annually take part, giving the whole event a real European flavour. Developed originally as a showcase for traditional food producers in the counties of Denbighshire and Conwy, the event has grown from one room in the International Pavilion to now filling the whole building and sometimes spreading into Llangollen itself. Over 100 different exhibitors offer everything from organic meats to fruit lacquers, Welsh cheeses, bread, chocolate, fish - anything you can think of, you'll find it at this fantastic culinary event.

#### RM Trail Riding

RM trail Riding offer professionally guided trail riding in and around North Wales, suitable for all standards of rider. Why not come along and experience riding in one of the most breautiful scenic locations in North Wales?

Ride on by-ways and legal rights of way across the beautiful countryside of North Wales, linked up by tarmacced roads, including A and B roads.


#### Llangollen International Music Eisteddfod

MANIC STREET PREACHERS will headline the 2024 Trentham Live four-day event on Saturday 17th August.

Set in a unique lakeside setting, the band will be returning to the Trentham Estate for the first time since 1998.

Manic Street Preachers are one of the most influential and iconic rock bands to have come out of Wales. Formed in Blackwood they have gone on to release 14 studio albums and have headlined countless festivals including Glastonbury, T in the Park, V Festival and Reading & Leeds. They have won eleven NME

Awards, eight Q Awards and four BRIT Awards and were also nominated for the Mercury Prize and the MTV Europe Music Awards.

Their first album, 1992's 'Generation Terrorists', established them as unique artists, and throughout the years they have collected fans from all over the world, maturing and changing musically whilst always keeping the classic Manics sound. At their live shows

early tracks such as 'You Love Us' and 'Motorcycle Emptiness' comfortably sit alongside huge chart hits such as the No. 1 single 'If You Tolerate This Your Children Will Be Next' and other tracks such as 'You Stole The Sun From My Heart' and 'Design For Life' alongside newer songs such as 'Orwellian' and 'The

Secret He Had Missed', both taken from their most recent album 'The Ultra Vivid Lament' which reached No. 1 in the UK Album Charts in September 2021.

## Some of the best parks to visit in Wrexham, Chester & Flintshire this Spring...

#### Moss Valley Country Park

Moss Valley Country Park is situated between

miles north of Wrexham. The V-shaped valley has woodland with oak and beech trees, as well as two small lakes and areas of open grassland. The valley provides a rich habitat for wildlife and is particularly noted for its birds.

Moss Valley has an industrial past, and was once a major coal mining area. In 1973 the spoil heaps were reclaimed, but amongst the tranquil woodland and meadows, evidence of the old railways can still be found.

Pathways run through the park, often following old tramways and railway lines that were once used to extract the coal and sandstone from the valley. Although the coal mines have long since gone, the small sandstone quarries still exist offering excellent wildlife habitats hidden away amongst the trees.

#### Alyn Waters Country Park

The largest country park in the Wrexham area; Alyn Waters is situated in the beautiful Alyn Valley and is a Green Flag

Award



accredited site. There are a variety of woodland, grassland and riverside walks throughout the park helping you to explore the whole site.



The park is split into two either side of the River Alyn.

The Gwersyllt side offers parking, a visitor centre with café, gift shop and toilets including baby change facilities. The visitor centre also has fully equipped conference and meeting rooms, as well as a

permanent exhibition on the history and wildlife of the park. The Llay side of the park has a large car park, children's playground and a local nature reserve.



## The Uwydian Range and Dee Valley

The Clwydian Range and Dee Valley form a dramatic upland frontier in North Wales, with scenic landscapes, dramatic summits and historic towns and villages.

The heather-clad hills of the Clwydian Range that reward the adventurer with ancient hillforts and incredible views give way to the Dee Valley's rich cultural and industrial heritage. The distinctive beauty and significance of this exceptional landscape is protected and enhanced as one of only five Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty in Wales.



#### Bellevue Park

Bellevue is a popular traditional park within easy walking distance of the town centre. Visitors can see a splendid formal landscape in the Edwardian style. There are shaded avenues of mature lime trees that extend from the bandstand area, along with areas of newer tree planting and ornamental shrub beds.

A network of well-surfaced pathways provides access to all corners of the park, with period lamps illuminating the park in the evening. From a small hill next to the park's basketball court you can see views over Wrexham, the Parish Church and the surrounding hills. There is also a sensory garden near the park entrance, overlooked by a statue of Queen Victoria.

Bellevue Park was first given Green Flag Award accreditation in 2005 and has held it each year since then.



#### Greenfield Valley Museum and Heritage Park

Greenfield Valley Heritage Park is situated in Holywell, Flintshire and encompasses 70 acres of industrial history.

Historically Greenfield Valley employed hundreds of people in both its copper factories and cotton mills and is now fabulous open green space. The Valley is home to a number of scheduled ancient monuments and is a haven for wildlife. The free Visitor Centre contains information on the industry, activities and walks. Greenfield Valley is managed by Greenfield Valley Trust, a reistered charity resulting from The Friends of Greenfield Valley in 1980's to learn more visit Greenfield Valley Museum & Heritage Park website.

#### Grosvenor Park

The award-winning Grosvenor Park located overlooking the River Dee is a popular open space for both locals and visitors and is home to the glorious Grosvenor Park Open Air Theatre each Summer.




There's plenty of space to let off steam and children will love the Miniature railway and Activity Zone. Refreshments are available from the onsite Lodge Cafe.



Sandy Lanc Park and Aqua Park

Sandy Lane Park is situated upon the banks of the River Dee, approximately 2.5 miles east of Chester city centre and includes Sandy Lane Aqua Park and the adjacent play area which looks across the River Dee to the Meadows. The park has beautiful views of the local area, which provides a stimulating play environment and the Aqua Park/Water Park includes a 10 feature spray facility close to a grassed picnic area. The Aqua Park and toilets are only open during the summer season (May - September), between 11am - 5pm. Please note that there may be a possibility that the Aqua Park may need to close for an hour to undertake maintenance, this is likely to be sometime between 1pm - 3pm. The adjacent play area remains open during the winter months.









## Rhubarb & gingernut cheesecake

What could be more cheerful than this vivid pink no-bake cheesecake? Rhubarb and ginger are merry bedfellows and make a stunning springtime dessert.

#### **Ingredients**

- 500g forced rhubarb, chopped into 4cm lengths
- 150g caster sugar
- 1 blood orange, zested and juiced
- 1 vanilla pod
- 100g butter, melted, plus extra for the tin
- 200g gingernut biscuits
- 500g mascarpone or soft cheese
- 100g quark or thick natural yoghurt
- 1 tbsp pistachios, chopped

#### Method

1 Heat oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Line a large baking tray with baking parchment and fill with the rhubarb. Scatter over the sugar and orange zest and pour over the juice. Scrape the seeds from the v.anilla pod in there too, throwing the spent pod on top. Cover with foil and roast for 20 mins. Remove from the oven. Purée a third of the rhubarb, reserving the rest for the top.

2 Butter a 20cm springform cake tin and line it with baking parchment. To make the base, put the biscuits in a bag and smash them with a rolling pin, or put them in a food processor and grind to crumbs. Tip into a mixing bowl, and stir in a pinch of sea salt. Pour the butter over the crumbs. Mix it together with a fork and tip it into the tin. Tap the side of the tin with your hand to even the crumbs out, and gently compress it with the back of a large spoon until it's packed in and level. You want it fairly well packed so that it holds together. Put in the fridge to chill.

- 3 To make the filling, put the cheese and quark or yogurt into a mixing bowl, or the bowl of a stand mixer, and beat it together. Mix until combined and thickened, then fold through the rhubarb purée.
- 4 Pile the mixture on top of the biscuit base and smooth it down. Cover with cling film and chill overnight until set. Remove the rhubarb from its syrup with a slotted spoon, tip the syrup into a pan and bring to the boil. Reduce for about 3-5 mins until the syrup is more concentrated. Allow to cool.
- 5 Carefully remove the cheesecake from its tin. Pile the rhubarb on top and drizzle over some syrup (you can save the rest for drizzling over porridge), then scatter with the pistachios to serve.







## Wrexham market's historic secrets

The historic secrets of Wrexham's Butchers Market are being uncovered during a major renovation project – with some original features incorporated into the refurbishment.

Work started in the summer on a complete refurbishment of both buildings, with SWG Construction leading the project on behalf of Wrexham County Borough Council.

Josh Coleman, Commercial Director of SWG Construction, said work was going well – with several interesting features being uncovered.

"We have been making good progress, with the mechanical and electrical first fix nearing completion in the Butchers Market, along with new perimeter stall ceilings and stud walls being installed," he said.

"Underground drainage and ductwork have been installed ready to serve the new market stalls, and scaffolding has been erected for stone and chimney repairs.

"During the excavation work in the Butch-

ers Market, the archaeologists discovered a wall which was documented before the excavation was backfilled, as well as various historic shopfronts which had previously been covered up.

"These are now being incorporated in refurbishing the new shop fronts.
An original stone staircase has also been uncovered to the first-floor vaulted room. This is all being left in place and will be on view when the market reopens."

He added: "Perimeter stalls in the Butchers Market are now being boarded and walls and ceilings being plastered over the coming weeks. Specialist stonemasons are repairing the façade and chimney on the High Street elevation.

"In the General Market, we are now decorating and installing steel and timber boarding. It's really coming together and both markets will look great when they are reopened."

The markets are an integral part of Wrexham's past and present Councillor Nigel Williams, Wrexham Council's Lead

Member for Economy and Regeneration, said: "Wrexham is riding the crest of a wave at the moment thanks to a growing global profile, and is welcoming more and more visitors from all over the world. This is a really exciting time for the city.

"SWG Construction is making good progress with the renovation work, and I'm looking forward to seeing the project completed later this year."

The Grade II-listed General and Butchers markets are being refurbished as part of the Wrexham Townscape Heritage Scheme, funded through the National Lottery Heritage Fund, (with thanks to the National Lottery Players), Welsh Government – Transforming Towns Fund, and Wrexham County Borough Council capital programme.

# The most violent game in English football history

On April 29, 1970, Chelsea met Leeds United at Old Trafford in an FA Cup Final replay. The two clubs had 'history', and the first

meeting, played on a Wembley pitch rendered virtually unplayable after hosting the Horse Of The Year Show, was niggly and badtempered. That was nothing, however, compared to the re-match three weeks later.

Chelsea's Ron 'Chopper' Harris began proceedings by almost cutting Leeds winger Eddie Gray in half after only two minutes. The match continued in the same vein, with 'dirty' Leeds giving as good as they got, and more besides.

Staggeringly, there was only one booking, for a push on Leeds captain Billy Bremner by lan Hutchinson.

The game was re-refereed, according to modern interpretations of the rules, by Michael Oliver in 2020, who was forced to concede that he would have handed out 11 red cards. Chelsea's lan Hutchinson neatly summed it up: "We hated them and they hated us."

Chelsea, incidentally, won 2-1 after extra-time.

#### **1982** Start of the Falklands War



On April 2, 1982, after several years of failed diplomacy, Argentine forces mounted amphibious landings, known as Operation Rosario, on the Falkland Islands. The invasion started with the landing of Lieutenant Commander Guillermo Sanchez-Sabarots' Amphibious Commandos Group. This was followed by the invasion of South Georgia the next day.

On April 5, the British government dispatched a naval task force to engage the Argentine Navy and Air Force before making an amphibious assault on the islands. The conflict lasted 74 days and ended with an Argentine surrender on 14 June, returning the islands to British control. In total, 649 Argentine military personnel, 255 British military personnel, and three Falkland Islanders were killed during the hostilities.

#### **Maximum fine for Wrexham company**

A company in Wrexham has received the maximum fine possible by Wrexham Magistrate's Court after failing to comply with Advertisement Regulations.

After an illuminated sign was erected on an e-cig shop on Hope Street, Wrexham Council contacted the owners to advise them that the sign needed to be smaller and the illumination turned off, but this was not done.

Consequently, the company was taken to court and fined the maximum amount possible by the Magistrates – £1000 with an additional £400 victim support and £280 costs.

The court have made it clear that if the works aren't completed within the next week they would expect the council to issue a further prosecution.

Councillor Hugh Jones, lead member for strategic planning and public protection, said: "Wrexham Council takes failure to comply with planning regulations very seriously.

"Our planning officers are always happy to advise businesses to make sure they work within the rules, which are there to protect the County Borough and its residents. 
